Topped with a Kolams quartz countertop from Wilsonart (another reader pick), a freestanding vanity reinforces the airy feel while a wall-mounted brushed nickel faucet (Weymouth by Moen; moen.com) frees up limited counter space. Inspired by the roughhewn wood found throughout the historic home, porcelain plank floors (yes, they're porcelain, not wood!) are easy to care for and pair with the shower's white hexagonal tiles for a fresh but not-too-modern feel. Designed by a local woodworker, the distressed cherry wood medicine cabinet reins in bathroom essentials.
